Built in 1860, 20th Century Theatre is a beautiful English Heritage listed building in Notting Hill that offers the opportunity to create an environment that is memorable for effective events



20th Century Theatre—W11

Built around 1860, it was used as a theatre prior to becoming the London Opera School and a venue for professional and amateur theatre groups. Charles Dickens is known to have read his stories from the stage in 1862 and Laurence Olivier made his debut here as well.

The 20th Century Theatre is a Grade II listed English Heritage Building and fully restored Victorian London venue that is an ideal backdrop for conferences and meetings. It boasts 1,800 sq. ft. of floor space plus adjoining reception room located in Notting Hill Gate.
