### Court Room

The Court Room is one of London's finest surviving Rococo interiors. Its collection of paintings, sculptures, decorations and a fine plasterwork ceiling make the whole room a sumptuous work of art that can be used for intimate dinners.

### Picture Gallery

The Picture Gallery can accommodate dinners for as many as 100 and receptions for up to 200. It contains all the major portraits in the collection and is a fitting setting for concerts, conferences and lectures. In addition to the Picture Gallery and Court Room there are less formal, contemporary rooms available for hire which would facilitate seminars and meetings. The new museum is a stunning mix of historic and contemporary spaces and has modern catering facilities, making it an appropriate venue for a range of events and functions.
