Built in 1802, the warehouse which is home to Museum of London Docklands was originally used to store vast quantities of rum, molasses, coffee, pimento and cotton from the West India slave plantations

Sailortown

Sailortown recreates the streets of London's docklands as they were in 1840, a network of narrow streets and alleyways lined with pubs and shops. The reception can then continue, or guests can be seated for dinner, in the City and River gallery, home to an 1807 model of the Lord Mayor's state barge.

For evening events the quayside doors can be opened allowing your guests direct access to the outside south facing terrace. It has a cloakroom and is air-conditioned.
