Roundhouse—NW1

The Roundhouse is a historic steam engine repair building that became a legendary venue in the 1960s and '70s. This is where punk and glam rock started, where The Rolling Stones, Jimi Hendrix and Pink Floyd made their names and The Doors played their only UK gig.

It hosted the most spectacular and controversial theatrical performances of its day including works by Peter Brook and the Living Theatre from New York.

The iconic Roundhouse can host receptions and parties for 20 to 1,800 guests, meetings for up to 1,700 or banquets for 20 to 1,200 guests. Smaller rooms are available for hire with or without the stunning main space.
