Eltham Palace is one of London's most unique and exceptional venues. From corporate meetings to weddings, this elegant and versatile location will dazzle guests with its tranquil moated gardens and beautiful Great Hall.



As the childhood home of Henry VIII, Eltham Palace was once a significant royal abode. Today, however, only the medieval Great hall remains of the original buildings.

In the 1930s, millionaires Stephen and Virginia Courtauld chose Eltham Palace as the location for an innovative art deco mansion project. A series of elegant rooms were created by the most influential designers of the time, and with its Hollywood-style glamour and incorporation of the surviving Great Hall, the palace became the unique place it is today.
