



WELLINGTON ARCH

For a unique and spectacular event location, Wellington Arch is simply unbeatable with its breath taking views, fascinating history, convenient location and beautiful interior.

Designed by architect Decimus Burton in 1825, Wellington Arch was built to commemorate Britain's victory over Napoleon and as an outer entrance to Buckingham Palace. In 1882 it fell victim to a road-widening scheme. The entire structure was dismantled, moved 20 metres and rebuilt in its current location.

Few people realise this famous landmark hides one of London's most fashionable party venues within its magnificent arched walls. As guests arrive, they are often surprised to be whisked up to its towering heights, where stylish rooms offer a sophisticated setting for daytime or evening events.
